This will be an Interactive Wine reception Featuring Food Pairing Stations with HLCC Executive Chef Kerry Armbruster.

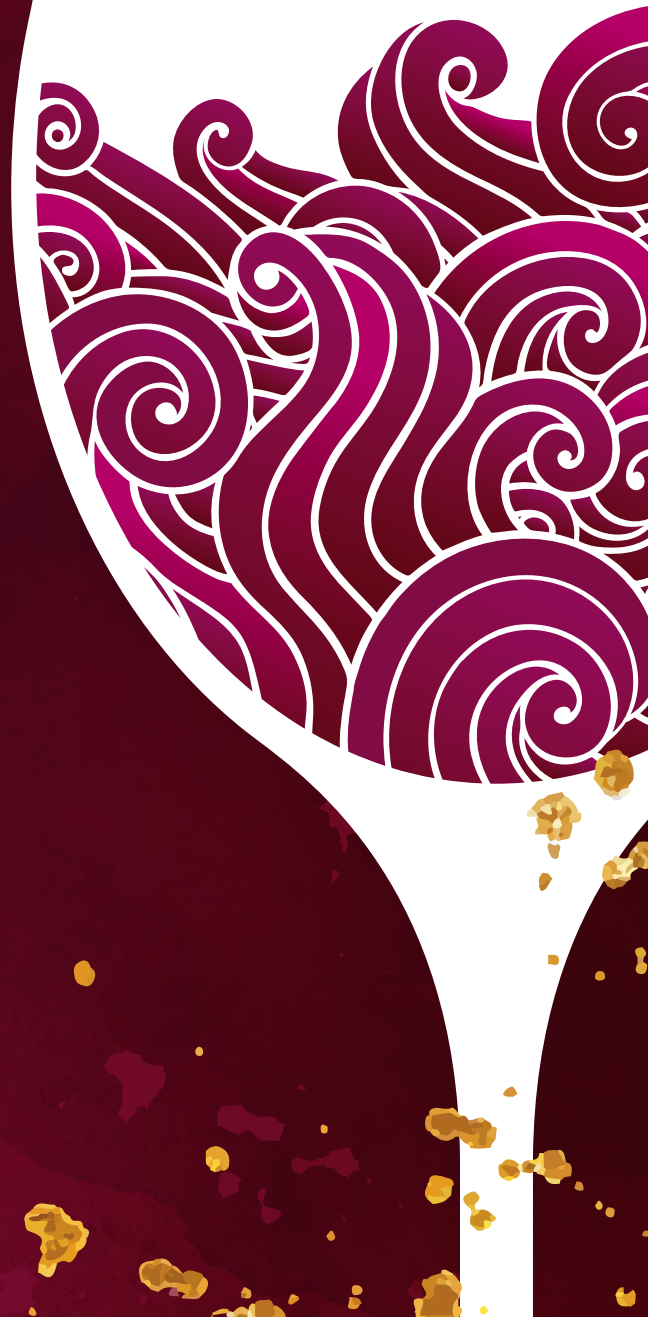

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



## **1. When are unaccompanied guest allowed at the Club?**

A limited number of unaccompanied guest are allowed to join us on our golf course, use our Net Facilities and experience our wonderful food during Sunday Brunch. As HLCC works to return to pre-COVID membership usage and pre-COVID membership levels, we will allow unaccompanied guests to visit our club in hopes of attaining new members and continue to expand our services.

## **2. Are unaccompanied guest allowed at all dining services?**

Other than Sunday Brunch, ALL other dining services are for the exclusive use of our Members and their Guest.

## **3. Is it okay to walk or jog on the golf course?**

It is generally not advisable for walkers or joggers to be on a golf course during play. One of the main reasons is safety. Golf balls are fast moving projectiles that can certainly cause damage if they strike someone. The second reason is common courtesy. Could you imagine someone walking across a tennis court or football field mid game? And of course there is the financial part. Golf is an expensive sport to play and a golfer has paid that fee to have an unencumbered round. Also no one pays higher dues than members that have the Full or Golf memberships.

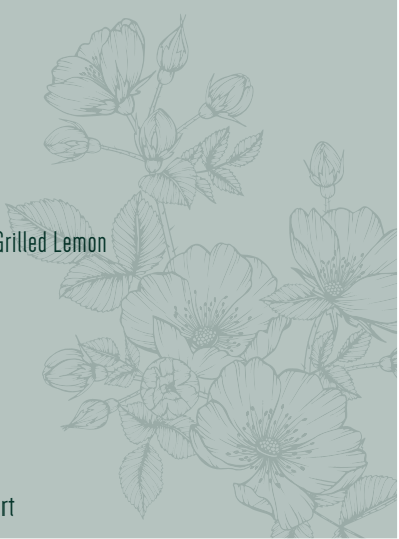

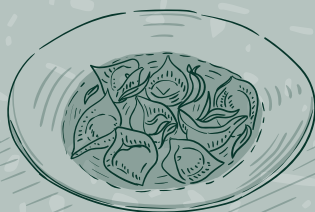

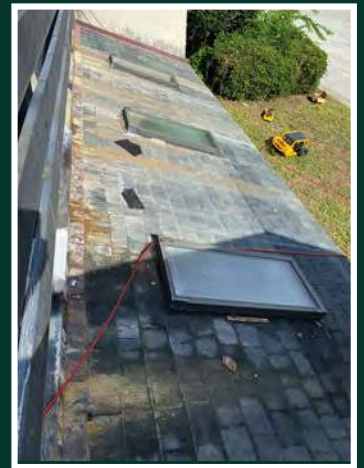

## The Spirit of the Game

Golf is unlike any other sport, it is played without the supervision of a referee or umpire. Integrity and accountability are the two most important aspects of the game of golf. We wanted to provide subtle reminders when playing at Houndslake Country Club.

### Reminders:

- Replace divots in the fairway and ball marks on the greens
- No carts allowed on all Par 3's
- Keep golf carts 30 feet and push carts 5 feet from greens at all times
- Keep up with the group in front of you. Allotted time to play is no more than 2 hours and 10 minutes per 9 holes
- Please rake all bunkers
- Please follow our dress policy at all times (Golf shirts, soft spike tennis shoes, and golf shorts, skirts, or pants.)
- Please adhere to SC state liquor laws which state NO ALCOHOL may be brought onto the golf course EXCEPT alcohol purchased in the Pro Shop
- No outside coolers are permitted on the course (The Pro Shop will provide ice bags for those who need to keep purchased drinks cold)
