



Implementing an HCC VOLUNTEER STARTER PROGRAM

With HCC open to public for golfing, certain issues arise between those golfers accustomed to playing at a municipal (minimum rules) course -vs- playing at a country club (more specific rules) course. Having a Golf Starter at the beginning of play may mitigate some of these issues. The following outlines the HCC Golf Starter Program:

PRO SHOP

MANNED BY HCC STAFF

- Assigns tee times based upon golfer status (HCC members have priority) and availability
- Collects for green fees/cart rental/practice balls/rental clubs/food & beverages
- Controls golf cart keys
- Provides Starter with copy of tee sheet, which includes the tee time, name of person who made the tee time, and the number of golfers who will be playing in that group
- Puts HCC Golf Rules (including sand trap rakes) in cart display windows
- Provide Starter w a cart that is flagged by a red STARTER sign

STARTER STATION

MANNED BY HCC MEMBER VOLUNTEERS

- It is important to be welcoming and respectful to all golfers (members or not)
- Controls pace of play on golf course by directing players to the first tee at the appropriate times
- Reviews tee sheet; resolves any questions or issues with Pro Shop (communicates with Pro Shop via mobile text messaging)
- For each group, records tee time, cart #s, golfers names (for public & selected HCC groups, plus guests of members) (Record cart numbers per group for follow-up if problems arise, track pace of play, and to be able to find a golfer, if needed)
- · Announces golf group on tee and next golf group to follow
- Enforces doubling up on cart usage
- Provides info on course conditions, rules of play, course maintenance expectations, etc.
- Supplies players with score cards & pencils
- Start with Fridays & Saturdays
- Each Starter volunteer would work \sim 3-hour shift (7:30 10:30 am; 10:30 am 1:30 pm)

If you are interested in serving as an HCC Volunteer Starter, please provide your name, phone number, and the general days/hours you would be able to serve via the sign-up sheet in the Pro Shop or phone the Pro Shop. This program definitely will help the control of play at HCC.



Did You Know?

If you provided credit card information for your account when joining, you will always receive an email statement on the 1st of every month for you to review. If the accounting department does not hear from you, they will "assume" everything is correct. Between the 10th and 15th of every month is when they will process your credit card.

We are in the process of setting up everyone's email in the credit card processor. Once your credit card is processed, you should receive an email notification. Thank Jou Members
