
## **NEIGHBORHOOD NEWS**

Tee Talk

If you are inconsistent with your sand play (sometimes too far, sometimes too short), your club is entering the sand either too close or too far behind your ball. Practice this drill until you can hit the line a high percentage of the time. Now the next time you are in the sand bunker, just keep in your mind, hit the line!
