

TEE TALK

The Lie of the Land



How do you play uphill or downhill lies?

It is only natural that when faced with a shot from an uphill lie to lean left (right handed golfers) into the slope of the hill for balance. When you have a downhill lie, you tend to lean against the slope.

The next time you have these kinds of lies, try this. Make sure your shoulders are tilted the same as the slope. For example, for uphill lies your shoulders will be tilted more than normal, and for downhill lies, less than normal.
