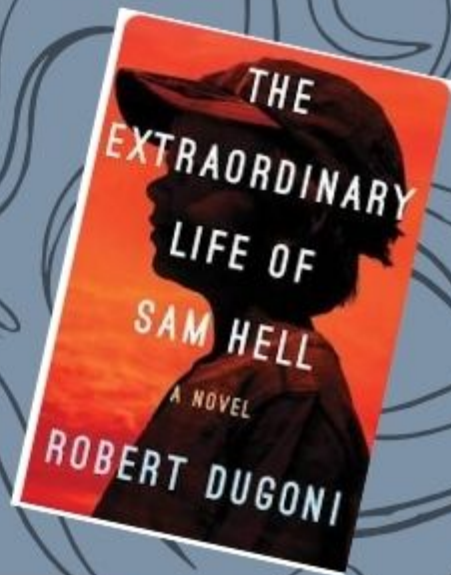


Houndslake Book Club **CELEBRATED 10 YEARS THIS MONTH!**
